## **Reintegrate is a 5-year project exploring how processes to govern reintegration impact the experiences of return migrants.**

Many people do not have the right to stay in countries of migration and return to their country through different types of programmes and policies. This return can be chosen or it can be forced.

Once people come back, they often experience an adjustment period. There can be lots of joy at being at back and spending time with family. But there can also be challenges such as finding a new job and reconnecting in society.

In some countries there are supports offered to people returning to help them adjust after their return.

## **Why is your story important?**

**People who have migrated and returned to their country have many different experiences in their migration and return. Little is known about how different countries support people coming back and if support does or does not impact returnees experiences. We want to hear about your experience and what has helped you or not in your experience of adjusting. What would be useful to you? Do you have any recommendations on how to improve services to returnees? We want to hear your story and understand how we can make suggestions to support return migrants.**

## **How will I learn about your story?**

We will listen to you and ask you questions about your experience of migration and your return. If there is any question you do not want to answer that is ok and we will move on.

## **What about your privacy?**

Participation in this research is always voluntary and you can opt out of the interview at any time and up to 30 days after the interview has been completed. Your name and contact information will be kept private and not shared with others.

## **How will this project benefit you?**

Participation in this project will not benefit you directly. We are unable to assist you in your current situation. We hope to learn from you to make suggestions for policies that might assist people in the future.
